CALL FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST
COMMERCIAL TENANCY
KORMAN EMERGENCY SHELTER

The Greater Port Vila Urban Resilience project is constructing three emergency shelters in Port Vila and designing the next three. One of those under construction is located a Korman which will be ready to occupy towards the End of March 2026.

Port Vila City Council (PVCC) invites expressions of interest for leasing of all or part of the Emergency shelter during the times where it is not used as an emergency shelter.

Importantly, if the expression of interest is for use of all or part of the ground floor of the building, the uses for which the Council will consider are only those where the lessee can remove its possessions within a period of 4 hours after either the National Disaster Management Office (NDMO) issues a Yellow cyclone alert for Port Vila, or the President declares an emergency under the National Disaster Act. This will allow time for the building to transition to an emergency shelter.

Usually when a cyclone or earthquake hits Port Vila businesses cease to trade but still incur lease/rental and utilities costs. This is an opportunity for a business to cease to trade and not incur those costs until after the emergency and it is ready to trade again.

Please note this request does not apply to the shelters under construction at Freshwater Field and Seaside Market which will be community focussed facilities
